**CIRCULAR**

The Port Blair Municipal Council Solid Waste (Handling and Management) Bye-Laws, 2017, stipulates the duties and responsibilities of waste generators and its management. As per the Clause 6(21), the Construction and Demolition waste (C & D waste) shall be stored and delivered separately by the generator and stored in segregated manner at source. The generator must then call a local Help-line of the Port Blair Municipal Council or the Agent of Port Blair Municipal Council, who will then send a vehicle to pick up the segregated C&D waste from the generator, with a specified charges, and then further transport this wastes to a processing centre or disposal site within 07(seven) days of generation.

Further, the violator who will not removing Construction and Demolition waste in a segregated manner as specified they will be fined at Rs.5000.00 per ton as per S.No.:11 of Schedule-I of the Bye-laws.

Therefore, keeping in view of above, PBMC has earmarked following C&D deposition points for storage & re-use purposes at different places under the jurisdiction of Junior Engineer-Road Works, PBMC:

1. C&D Waste Storage Unit at Anarkali (For Ward No.:01-08),
2. C&D Waste Storage Unit at AIR Road (For Ward No.: 01-08),
3. C&D Waste Storage Unit at VIP Road (For Ward No.: 10-13)
4. C&D Waste Storage Unit at Dairy Farm (For Ward No.:09,14-16),
5. C&D Waste Storage Unit at Dollygunj (For Ward No.:17-24),

In order to facilitate the citizens, to lodge their C&D Waste requisition to transport from PBMC on usual charges basis may visit to pbmc.gov.in the C&D Waste Management or may directly visit to <https://forms.gle/hUkAPfGVEsrfixCT8> or may scan QR-Code or may call to PBMCs Control Room No.: 03192-231179.



On receipt of such queries, an email and call will be sent/ made to the concerned Road works Junior Engineers for onward collection of C&D Waste and levy of user charges through PoS machine, may be issued from the Revenue Officer of PBMC.

The road works Junior Engineers may collect the C&D Waste and deposit at designated C&D collection Points and shall maintain a separate waste collection register. And, may utilize the same for various construction purposes as per suitability.

The analyzed user-charges for the collection of C&D Waste from the public/ waste generator are given below:

Sl. No.	User-charges for C&D Waste with & without Excavator	Violation of norms w.r.t. C&D Waste generator
1	900.00 per cum./ton	5000.00 per ton

In case of any violation of norms pertaining to C&D Waste from the waste generators, the Sanitary Inspector of the respective ward may impose a spot fine to violator and a lean period may be given to the violator for clearance and deposition of C&D Waste at the above mentioned designated locations of PBMC or may ask to deposit the amount for collection of same by the concerned ward Junior Engineer-Road works.
